A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY REGARDING THE DISCHARGE OF SOLID WASTE AND SEDIMENT FROM TIJUANA, MEXICO, AND DECLARING A CONTINUED STATE OF EMERGENCY REGARDING THE DISCHARGE OF RAW SEWAGE FROM TIJUANA, MEXICO.

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 8630 authorizes local governing bodies to proclaim local emergencies when such events occur as are defined by California Government Code section 8558(c); and

WHEREAS, solid waste and sediment flowing across the international border with Mexico, via the Tijuana River and other waterways, poses significant peril to persons and property in the City of San Diego by contaminating the soil and degrading the natural environment of the Tijuana River Valley; and

WHEREAS, the City has engaged in dredging, trash collection, and other efforts, but effective management of the pollution is beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego adopted San Diego Resolution R-282544 on September 7, 1993, declaring the existence of a state of emergency regarding the escalated discharge of raw sewage across the international border into the City from Tijuana, Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the raw sewage coming across the international border is a source of noxious odors and potentially harmful airborne microorganisms within the City; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 8630 further provides that the local

governing body review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every 60 days

until the governing body terminates the local emergency; and

WHEREAS, the escalated discharge of raw sewage across the international border into

the City of San Diego continues to pose the possibility of peril to persons and property; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that pursuant to California

Government Code section 8630, a state of emergency is declared to exist due to solid waste and

sediment coming from Tijuana, Mexico.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to California Government Code

section 8630, a continued state of emergency is declared to persist due to raw sewage coming from

Tijuana, Mexico.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute

all necessary contracts for the diversion, treatment, and disposal of raw sewage, solid waste, and

sediment coming from Tijuana, Mexico.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the measures previously taken by the Council of the

City of San Diego in Resolution R-282544 shall continue to have full force and effect.
