A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT AND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR PALM AVENUE TRANSITIONAL HOUSING IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, an application was submitted to the City of San Diego for a Coastal Development Permit and Conditional Use Permit (amending Conditional Use Permit No. 2053090) to rehabilitate an existing 61-room hotel into a transitional housing facility containing 42 rooms (84 beds), called the Palm Avenue Transitional Housing, located at 1788 Palm Avenue in the CC-4-2 zone within the Otay Mesa-Nestor Community Plan area (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code section 21000, *et seq.*), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000, *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2019, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment in that an environmental review was conducted, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15060, and determined that the project was exempt under the CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities). This determination was based on project review and project-specific technical documents.

Furthermore, the Project involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use, the site currently contains a hotel and the transitional use would continue to operate in the same manner; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the decision and where the City Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego.
