A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS FOR PHASE 1 OF PURE WATER SAN DIEGO WITHOUT A REQUIREMENT THAT APPRENTICES BE REGISTERED IN JOINT LABOR MANAGEMENT APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2018, the San Diego City Council authorized the Mayor or his designee to award the construction contracts for Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego, on the condition that the construction contracts include labor requirements consistent with the Memorandum from Patrick Bouteller, Director of Government Affairs, dated November 15, 2018, pursuant to San Diego Resolution R-312062; and

WHEREAS, these labor requirements included a condition that certain construction contracts require that all apprentices be registered in Joint Labor Management Apprenticeship Programs approved by the State of California; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2019, the San Diego Chapter of the Associated General Contractors (AGC) filed litigation against the City alleging that the Joint Labor Management Apprenticeship Program requirement violates City Proposition A, a local initiative that prohibits the City from requiring project labor agreements on City construction projects, with certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2019, the San Diego Superior Court granted AGC's request for a preliminary injunction prohibiting the City from awarding the construction contract for the North City Pure Water Facility so long as it includes a requirement that apprentices be registered

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in Joint Labor Management Apprenticeship Programs, reasoning that the requirement violates

the Statement of the People's Intent in Proposition A; and

WHEREAS, the City estimates that for each month construction of Phase 1 of

Pure Water San Diego is delayed, inflation and related factors will increase the cost of Phase 1

by \$4 million; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to avoid further delay of construction of Phase 1 of

Pure Water and the increased costs associated with that delay, and removing the requirement that

apprentices be registered in Joint Labor Management Apprenticeship Programs will allow the

City to proceed with construction while complying with the Court's injunction; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Mayor or his

designee is authorized to award construction contracts for Phase 1 of Pure Water

San Diego without a requirement that apprentices be registered in Joint Labor Management

Apprenticeship Programs, and the Joint Labor Management Apprenticeship Program

requirement in San Diego Resolution R-312062 is hereby repealed.
