A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES, VICTIM SERVICES AND PUBLIC SAFETY BRANCH, FAMILY JUSTICE CENTER PROGRAM AND TO AUTHORIZE THE SAN DIEGO CITY ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT, INCLUDING AMENDMENTS, EXTENSIONS, AND RENEWALS.

WHEREAS, in early 2018, the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES),

Victim Services and Public Safety Branch, Family Justice Center Program, submitted a Request
for Application to the San Diego Family Justice Center (SDFJC) seeking an application for a
non-competitive grant to improve the capabilities of established Family Justice Centers; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with San Diego Municipal Code section 22.5203, the SDFJC submitted its application for the grant to the Grants Review Team, which approved the application; and

WHEREAS, the grant was awarded to the City of San Diego (City) on behalf of the SDFJC in the amount of \$587,067 for the time period of January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement (Agreement) was previously approved on November 20, 2018, without Council action pursuant to Municipal Code section 22.5204; and

WHEREAS, Cal OES requires approval of the City's governing body for acceptance of the grant and for the authority of the public official signing the Agreement, along with any amendments, extensions, or renewals to the Agreement that may become necessary; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego,

That it accepts the grant award from Cal OES, Victim Services and Public Safety Branch, 1.

Family Justice Center Program in an amount not to exceed \$587,067 for the time period

of January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2020; and

2. That it retroactively authorizes the City Attorney to sign the Agreement and amendments,

extensions, or renewals of the Agreement that may become necessary for a period of up

to five years from FY 2019 through and including FY 2023; and

3. That it authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend up to \$587,067 in

grant funds from the Cal OES, Victim Services and Public Safety Branch, Family Justice

Program, including any amendments, extension or renewals for a period of up to five years

from FY 2019 through and including FY2023; and

That it ratifies any expenditures to date consistent with the award and the Agreement; and 4.

That it authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to establish an interest-bearing account for 5.
