A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF ALL MOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION DEVICES ON THE BOARDWALK IN MISSION BEACH AND PACIFIC BEACH, MISSION BAY PARK BAYSIDE WALK, AND LA JOLLA SHORES BOARDWALK IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301(C).

WHEREAS, the City intends to prohibit all such motorized transportation devices, including but not limited to scooters, from its Boardwalk from Mission Beach to Pacific Beach, Mission Bay Park Bayside Walk, and La Jolla Shores Boardwalk (Boardwalks); and

WHEREAS, modifications will be made to Chapter 8, Article 3, Division 3 of the San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) by amending section 83.0308 related to geofencing requirements for shared mobility device operators; and Chapter 8, Article 4, Division 0 by adding a new section 84.18, related to prohibiting the operation of all motorized transportation devices on the boardwalk in Mission Beach and Pacific Beach, Mission Bay Park Bayside Walk, and La Jolla Shores Boardwalk; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and

adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301(c) (existing facilities) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on _________, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the proposed amendments to the SDMC will alter the operation of existing facilities (the Boardwalks) with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301(c) and that an exception to the exemption does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
