A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING FEES AND FINES RELATING TO ANIMAL CONTROL REGULATIONS AND SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the California Health and Safety Code and the California Food and Agriculture Code establish some animal control regulations, and authorize a city to adopt its own comprehensive regulations related to animal control within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has adopted, and incorporated as the Animal Control Ordinance of the City of San Diego, the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances (Title 6, Division 2, Chapter 6) (County Code) that govern animal control regulations and services related to dog licensing; kennels; guard dogs; rabies vaccinations; treatment and isolation of diseased animals; unaltered dogs and cats; impoundment of strays, potentially dangerous dogs, cats, and other animals; and adoptions; and

WHEREAS, the California Health and Safety Code, California Food and Agriculture Code, and County Code authorize the City to charge fees and fines for animal control services; and

WHEREAS, as required by Article XIII C of the California Constitution, cities can only charge rates or fees that are equal to or less than the reasonably anticipated costs of proving the services, conferring the benefit, granting a privilege, performing regulatory duties, or enforcing law; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City to establish fees to recover the costs of providing services in accordance with the City of San Diego Administrative Regulation 95.25 and Council Policy 100-05; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City to review fees to ensure that all reasonable costs incurred in providing these services are being recovered; however, it is also the policy that fees are generally less than 100 percent cost recovery in cases where the purpose of the fee is not to generate revenue but rather provide benefits to the recipients (e.g. recreational activities); and

WHEREAS, the City's provider of animal control and services, the San Diego Human Society, reviewed the fees adopted by the City in April 2018, conducted a study, compared the fees to other shelters in the region, and is recommending that the fees be increased; and

WHEREAS, the recommended fees do not exceed the reasonable cost of providing the services or performing the regulatory duties and are either cost recoverable or are less than the cost to provide the service or care; and

WHEREAS, the City wants to revise the following fees and fines for animal control regulations and services; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the fees and fines related to animal control regulations and services, reflected in the summary table, as ATTACHMENT A, are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby directed to amend the fee schedule on file in the City Clerk's Office to include the animal control regulations and services fees and fines as reflected in ATTACHMENT A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the fees and fines as reflected in ATTACHMENT A shall be effective January 1, 2020.
