DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JAN 3.0 2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE PROGRAM MANAGER POSITION IN THE SUSTAINABILITY DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2019, the San Diego Civil Service Commission (Civil Service Commission) reviewed a request from the Sustainability Department (Department) to exempt one Program Manager position from the Classified Service of the City of San Diego (City); and

WHEREAS, the position will oversee the Fiscal and Administrative Division (Division) of the Department; develop and implement fiscal and administrative policy for the Department; establish budget and financial policies for operational accounting, energy forecasting, and billing; provide monthly and quarterly budget reports to the Department Director; monitor a variety of grants to ensure proper tracking and billing; and oversee the Division's energy billing team; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2019, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Manager position as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission

determined that the position meets the criteria set forth in Charter section 117 to be placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is presented to the City Council as set forth in the memorandum dated November 25, 2019 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Department initiated advisory review and comment from the Civil Service Commission related to the proposed exemption of one Program Manager position from the Classified Service. On November 21, 2019, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the proposed exemption and commented favorably upon it as meeting Charter section 117 criteria for placement of the Program Manager position in the Unclassified Service. Having considered and reviewed the finding of the Civil Service Commission, as set forth in the memorandum dated November 25, 2019 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, the City Council now exempts from the Classified Service the Program Manager position identified in the memorandum by the Department, performing the duties described in the memorandum, and declares the position to be in the Unclassified Service.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage. APPROVED: MARA W.
