AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING THREE PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITIONS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2020, the San Diego Civil Service Commission (Civil Service Commission) reviewed a request from the Police Department (Department) to exempt three Program Coordinator positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, two Program Coordinator positions will be responsible for formulating and administering Department policies and programs for the Support Operations Division. These positions will formulate and coordinate new and existing policies in alignment with City standards and the Criminal Justice Information Services Security Policies required of law enforcement agencies; provide input on Citywide Administrative Regulations and information technology governance and operational processes; and recommend policies and procedures related to data retention, file sharing for case submissions to prosecutors, and accessing sensitive law enforcement databases; and

WHEREAS, one Program Coordinator position will be responsible for overseeing the Advanced Initiatives Section in the Office of Homeland Security Division. This position will formulate and administer policies, procedures, and plans related to strategic statewide planning for the region and San Diego urban area; develop and coordinate a multi-jurisdictional network to identify challenges for incorporating strategic initiatives in the areas of prevention, protection, response, mitigation, and recovery, and incorporate them into Citywide emergency planning efforts; develop formal policies, procedures, and plans related to strategic statewide planning efforts supporting FEMA's national preparedness framework to include the Emergency

Operations Plan and Continuity of Operations Planning; oversee and develop Citywide emergency plans, protocols, and procedures; and oversee Risk Management and Threat Analysis programs and procedures associated with security strategies and reports; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter (Charter) section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the three Program

Coordinator positions as described by the Department to the Civil Service Commission, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding of the Civil Service Commission is presented to the Council as set forth in the memorandum dated June 9, 2020, to the Honorable Council President and members of the Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Police Department initiated advisory review and comment from the Civil Service Commission related to the proposed exemption of three Program Coordinator positions from the Classified Service. On June 4, 2020, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the proposed exemption and commented favorably as meeting Charter section 117 criteria for placement of the positions in the Unclassified Service. Having

considered and reviewed the finding of the Civil Service Commission, as set forth in the

memorandum dated June 9, 2020, to the Honorable Council President and members of the

Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, the

Council now exempts from the Classified Service the three Program Coordinator positions

identified in the memorandum by the Police Department, performing the duties described in the

memorandum, and declares the positions to be in the Unclassified Service.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
