DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JAN 30 2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO'S JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE DEVELOPER OF THE SOUTHWEST VILLAGE AND MARKET STREET COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT, OR ITS DEVELOPMENT DESIGNEE, FOR A LOAN AND A GRANT FROM THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000,000.

WHEREAS, the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) Program, established under Division 44, Part 1 of the Public Resources Code section 75200 et seq., funds certain types of project areas by providing grants and/or loans that will achieve greenhouse gas emissions reductions and benefit disadvantaged communities by increasing accessibility of affordable housing and sustainable transportation; and

WHEREAS the AHSC Program is administered by the Strategic Growth Council (SGC) and implemented by the California Department of Housing and Community Development (Department); and

WHEREAS, the State of California, SGC, and the Department issued a Notice of Funding Availability under the AHSC Program dated November 1, 2019 (NOFA), with an application deadline of February 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City will work with The Related Companies of California, LLC, a California limited liability corporation and the Jacobs Center for Neighborhood Innovation, a California non-profit public benefit corporation (collectively, Developer), to develop affordable housing units and to provide pedestrian and bicycle focused infrastructure improvements in the Southeast San Diego neighborhood near Euclid Avenue and Naranja Streets (Project); and

WHEREAS, Developer and the City of San Diego (City), as joint applicants, will apply for up to \$30,000,000 in AHSC Program funds, of which up to \$20,000,000 will be requested as a loan to Developer (or its Project development designee) for the Project (AHSC Loan) and up to \$10,000,000 will be requested as a grant to the City for Housing-Related Infrastructure (HRI), Sustainable Transportation Infrastructure (STI), Transit-Related Amenities (TRA) or Program (PGM) activities (AHSC Grant); and

WHEREAS, if awarded AHSC Program funds, the City will enter into, execute, and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement (Standard Agreement), which fully incorporates the application for AHSC Program funds under the NOFA (AHSC Program Application); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized and directed to apply, jointly with Developer, to the Department for the AHSC Program funds and execute and submit the AHSC Program Application as detailed in the NOFA, in a total amount not to exceed \$30,000,000 of which up to \$20,000,000 will be requested as an AHSC Loan to Developer, or its Project development designee, for the Project and up to \$10,000,000 will be requested as an AHSC Grant to the City for grant-eligible purposes.

2. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized to enter into and execute the Standard Agreement, all amendments and any and all documents necessary or appropriate to secure the AHSC Program funds from the Department.


