A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS FOR MIRA MESA TOWN COUNCIL AND ALLIANCE FOR QUALITY EDUCATION PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-23, TITLED "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING FOR ARTS, CULTURE AND COMMUNITY FESTIVALS WITH DISCRETIONARY TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX ALLOCATION."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-23, titled "City Council Funding of Arts, Culture and Community Festivals with Transient Occupancy Tax Allocation" on August 13, 2012, by Resolution R-307625; and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 100-23 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with private non-profit organizations that produce programs, projects and events that (i) provide access to excellence in culture and the arts for residents of, and visitors to San Diego, and (ii) enrich the lives of the people of San Diego and build healthy, vital neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the City received and evaluated two applications for Arts, Culture and Community Festivals (ACCF) funding for the following purposes:

ORGANIZATION	PROGRAM/ACTIVITY	PUBLIC BENEFIT	
Alliance for Quality Education	District 6 Night Market	Support a free, family- friendly, festive, open-air event that celebrates the diverse neighborhoods of Council District 6.	
Mira Mesa Town Council	Mira Mesa Fourth of July Celebration	Support a community based celebration that will uplift the Mira Mesa community.	

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described programs are consistent with the parameters outlined in Council Policy 100-23; and

WHEREAS, Council District 6 recommends an allocation of \$15,000 to Alliance for Quality Educational for support and supplies for the event set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 6 recommends an allocation of \$7,000 to Mira Mesa Town for support and supplies for the festival set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-23, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any goods, supplies, or materials which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, ACCF FY 2020 City Council Allocations Agreements between the City of San Diego and (1) Alliance for Quality Education in an amount not to exceed \$15,000, and (2) the Mira Mesa Town Council in an amount not to exceed \$7,000. Both are for the events described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-312837 for Alliance for Quality Education and Document No. RR-312837 for Mira Mesa Town Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$22,000 from the ACCF Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center 1106110006 GL512059, to provide funds for the

above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
