A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, AS RESPONSIBLE AGENCY, STATING THAT IT HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS OF THE JOINT USE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR STANDLEY MIDDLE SCHOOL, STANDLEY COMMUNITY PARK, AND SPRECKELS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AS SHOWN IN THE INITIAL STUDY/MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION PREPARED BY THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND ADOPTING A MITIGATION, MONITORING, AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) and the San Diego Unified School District (District) have been cooperating in the use of numerous recreational facilities and desire to enter into three Joint Use Agreements for the construction, maintenance, and use of Standley Middle School, Standley Community Park, and Spreckels Elementary School (Project); and

WHEREAS, the matter was heard at a public hearing on FEB 1 2020 , by the Council of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the District, as lead agency, prepared an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Standley Middle School and Spreckels Elementary School Joint Use Facilities Project (SCH 2017041080) (MND), which assessed the environmental impacts potentially resulting from the Project; and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2018, the District adopted the MND and the Mitigation, Monitoring, and Reporting Program (MMRP) with respect to the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that as a responsible agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), it has reviewed and considered

the MND prepared by the District as lead agency, considered the environmental effects of the

Project as shown in the MND, and that the information contained therein reflects the independent

judgement of the City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council, pursuant to California Public

Resources Code section 21081.6 and CEQA Guidelines section 15097, hereby adopts the MMRP

for the Project, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to

cause the filing of a Notice of Determination with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the

County of San Diego with respect to the MND, stating that the Council, as responsible agency,

considered the MND as prepared by the District in its capacity as lead agency.
