A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH POLYDYNE, INC. (BID NO. 10089553-19-V) TO PROVIDE CATIONIC POLYMER TO THE WATER FILTRATION PLANTS.

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department (PUD) utilizes approximately 1,170 dry lbs. of Cationic Polymer per year for the water filtration process used at the water treatment plants with other chemical coagulants to form a clarifying agent; and

WHEREAS, the City's Purchasing and Contracting Department issued an Invitation to Bid No. 10089553-19-V on May 13, 2019, to furnish Cationic Polymer, and after evaluation of the bids received and a thorough analysis of the samples submitted for testing, Polydyne, Inc. is the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, an award of this contract in the amount not to exceed \$3,334,105 would allow the anticipated expenditure of \$607,185 for FY 20 and \$681,730 for each of the four (4) years thereafter; and

WHEREAS, on October 29, 2019, the Public Utilities Department issued a Notice of Exemption pursuant to State CEQA Guideline section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and a Notice of Right to Appeal was issued on the same day; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a five (5) year contract with Polydyne, Inc. (Bid No. 10089553-19-V) to furnish Cationic Polymer to the Water Filtration Plants as-required, in an amount not to exceed \$3,334,105,

contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 312851.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$3,334,105 from Fund 700011, Water Utility Operating Fund, over a contract term of five (5) years for the purpose of funding the Cationic Polymer contract with Polydyne, Inc., contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
