

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 312852DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 20 2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZATION FOR REMAINING OPTION YEARS FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$9,384,614 WITH JCI JONES CHEMICALS, INC. TO PROVIDE CAUSTIC SODA 50% FOR WATER AND WASTEWATER FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department utilizes approximately 2,780 dry tons of Caustic Soda 50% per year for the water and wastewater treatment process. Caustic Soda is used at the water treatment plants to adjust the effluent pH for corrosion control throughout the City of San Diego's potable water distribution system. Caustic Soda is also used at the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant, Metropolitan Biosolids Center, and the wastewater pump stations (Metro Pump Station 1, Metro Pump Station 2, and Muni Peñasquitos Pump Station). Caustic Soda 50% is used to adjust the pH in the Odor Control Towers used to treat foul air in the wastewater treatment process. Insufficient or any interruption in the application of this chemical from the treatment or process would lead to federal and state water quality violations, and/or local Air Pollution Control District violations which could result in fines, penalties and even the closure of the plants mentioned above; and


WHEREAS, an Invitation to Bid, (BID 10089515-19-V) for a one (1) year, with (4), one (1) year renewal options, to furnish the City of San Diego with Caustic Soda, was issued by the Purchasing and Contracting Department on February 4, 2019. JCI Jones Chemicals, Inc. was the low, responsive and responsible bidder. On March 18, 2019, a one-year contract with the vendor was executed. Exercising the remaining four (4) one (1) year options will bring the total contract amount over the three-million-dollar authorization threshold of the Purchasing and Contracting Department. Therefore, City Council approval is required; and

WHEREAS, on October 29, 2019, the Public Utilities Department issued a Notice of Exemption pursuant to State CEQA Guideline section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and a Notice of Right to Appeal was issued on the same day; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or designee, to authorize four, one-year options to renew with JCI Jones Chemicals, Inc. (BID 10089515-19-V) to furnish Caustic Soda 50% as required in an amount not to exceed \$9,384,614, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer to expend an amount not to exceed \$9,384,614; \$7,949,850 from Fund 700011, Water Utility Operating Fund, \$1,353,532 from Fund 700001 Metro Sewer Utility Fund, and \$81,232 from Fund 700000, Muni Sewer Revenue Fund, for the purpose of funding the JCI Jones Chemicals, Inc. contract, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
