WHEREAS, the City of San Diego wants to adopt the 2019 editions of the California Building, Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical, Residential, California Green Building Standards Code and Existing Building Code and approve through ordinance amendments to the Municipal Code related to the Building, Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical, Residential Building Green Building and Existing Building Regulations (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000, et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000, et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) under the common sense exemption; and that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing significant effect on the environment; and

codes will require their own environmental review; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project

will not have a significant effect on the environment pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section

section 15061(b)(3).
