A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO A MARKETING PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT WITH AED BRANDS, LLC.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) has established a Corporate Partnerships and Development Program (CPDP) to generate revenue and develop resources for the City through partnerships with the corporate community; and

WHEREAS, in September 2019, the City issued a Request for Proposal and Marketing Partnership (RFP) for Automatic External Defibrillators (AED) & Related Supplies and San Diego Project Heart Beat Sponsorship; and

WHEREAS, the overall objectives of the RFP were to secure the best quality of pricing for AEDs for the City, and execute a Marketing Partnership Agreement (Agreement) with a qualified AED supplier to support the San Diego Project Heart Beat Program (SDPHB) in the Fire-Rescue Department by providing funding to the City in return for marketing opportunities available through the SDPHB sponsorship; and

WHEREAS, City staff analyzed the potential technical and marketing partnership of all proposals to the RFP and unanimously selected AED Brands, LLC (AED Brands); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement AED Brands will pay the City the following: 1) a marketing rights fee in the amount of \$100,000 per year; 2) a sales stipend in the amount of \$175 per AED sold within San Diego County and by SDPHB personnel, at a minimum of \$50,000 per year regardless of the volume of sales of AEDs; and 3) an annual promotional budget of no less than \$7,500 to be used for marketing initiatives that support SDPHB (collectively the "Marketing Fees"); and

WHEREAS, in consideration for the Marketing Fees, AED Brands will receive several

Marketing Rights and Partnership Benefits, including: 1) the right to be referred to as the

"Official AED Partner of the City of San Diego" and to use such designation in marketing

efforts; 2) appearing on the City's Public Access Defibrillation (PAD) program logo; and 3)

being named on the promotional materials in connection with the PAD program as the "Official

AED Partner of the City of San Diego"; and

WHEREAS, the proposed partnership with AED Brands is consistent with the City's

Marketing Partnership and Endorsement Policies; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Agreement is two years with three additional one-year

options whereby the City will receive a minimum of \$157,500 per fiscal year from AED Brands;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized and directed to execute the Agreement with AED Brands, LLC for a two

year term with three additional one-year options, and on the terms and conditions set forth in the

Marketing Partnership Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-
