A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE THIRTY-YEAR LEASE AGREEMENT WITH WEST COAST TURF FOR CITY-OWNED REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN SAN PASQUAL VALLEY IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301 AND SECTION 15303.

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.) states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHERAS, the City of San Diego desires to authorize the execution of that certain City of San Diego Lease with West Coast Turf, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-312909, for the lease of real property consisting of five hundred and seven acres of agricultural land located in the San Pasqual Valley in San Diego, California (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the approval of the

Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301

(Existing Facilities) and 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures),

and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2,

applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the

potential environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the

written record for the Project as well as public comment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its

independent judgement, determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA

pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 and section 15303, and that an exception to

the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
