A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY AMENDMENT OF COUNCIL POLICY 600-24, IN RESPONSE TO THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the Governor of California declared a state of emergency as a result of the threat of the novel coronavirus, COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, the Mayor of the City of San Diego proclaimed the existence of a local emergency related to the COVID-19 threat, which was ratified by the San Diego City Council on March 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, since that time, the Governor, the San Diego County Public Health Official (Public Health Official), and the Mayor have all issued directives and guidance to state and local residents to stay home or at their place of residence, except as needed to maintain continuity of operations of federal critical infrastructure sectors; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20, issued on March 12, 2020 and March 17, 2020, respectively, suspended provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act related to teleconferencing of meetings, permitting local jurisdictions to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and allowing members of the public to observe and address the meeting telephonically or otherwise electronically; and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to provide temporary amendments to Council Policy 600-24 to ensure the safety of Community Planning Group board members and the public; and

WHEREAS, these temporary amendments will not be added directly to the Council Policy 600-24 document; however, this resolution will act as an attachment to that

document for the life of these temporary amendments; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council temporarily amends Council Policy 600-24 as follows:

1. The following language is temporarily added to Article V:

Temporary Section 5.

COVID-19 Election Supplemental Procedures. Planning groups that have not held March elections prior to the declaration of local emergency due to the COVID-19 threat will be able to do so after the declaration of local emergency has been lifted.

However, if a planning group has not held March elections but has already chosen candidates for the March elections and the vacancies outnumber or equal the candidates, the candidates may be considered elected new members and the seating of new members will occur at that planning group's next meeting, or after the declaration of local emergency has been lifted if that planning group has opted not to meet during the state of emergency.

If a planning group has held March elections the seating of new members will occur at that planning group's next meeting, or after the declaration of local emergency has been lifted if that planning group has opted not to meet during the local emergency.

2. The following language is temporarily added to Article VI, Section 2:
Meetings held by teleconference or video conference during the declaration
of local emergency due to the COVID-19 threat. Planning groups that choose
to meet via teleconference or videoconference shall post a public notice of the
meeting and the meeting agenda at least 72 hours before the date of the meeting.

The notice with the agenda must provide information regarding how to join the teleconference or videoconference. This notice and the meeting agenda shall be posted on the planning group's website, if one exists. If a planning group does not have a website, they need to email the notice and meeting agenda to sdplanninggroups@sandiego.gov and it will be posted on Planning Department's planning group webpage.

Adjournment notices shall be posted on the planning group's website, if one exists. If a planning group does not have a website, they need to email the notice to sdplanninggroups@sandiego.gov and it will be posted on Planning Department's planning group webpage.

- 3. The following language is added temporarily to Article VI, Section 4:

 Roster procedures during the declaration of local emergency due to the

 COVID-19 threat. Planning groups that have held their March elections or have
 the same as or more vacancies than candidates, as specified in the provisions for
 Article V, Temporary Section 5, shall provide their updated roster information to
 the Planning Department.
- 4. The following language is added temporarily to Article VI, Section 6:

 Training during the declaration of local emergency due to the COVID-19

 threat. For planning groups that have held their March Elections or have the same as or more vacancies than candidates as specified in the Temporary

 Provisions for Article V, newly seated planning group members shall take the online training session (E-COW) within 60 days of being elected and are encouraged to attend the next in person training session made available once the local emergency has been lifted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these amendments are temporary and will expire with the lifting of the declaration of local emergency due to the COVID-19 threat except where compliance with these amendments would necessarily extend beyond that period. In those cases, the requirements of these amendments will expire once the requirement has been fulfilled.
