DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 05 2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$7,890 TO ELEMENTARY INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO PUBLIC SAFETY AND STUDENT SUPPLIES, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, Elementary Institute of Science has requested funding for improvements to public safety and for lab coats/student supplies (Program); and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used to implement security improvements that were recommended by the San Diego Police Department, and to purchase lab coats, goggles, and lab glassware; and

WHEREAS, the Elementary Institute of Science's request for funding for security measures will benefit the public by enacting safety measures around the school which will provide security to residents, visitors, and businesses alike; and

WHEREAS, the Elementary Institute of Science's request for funding for lab coats/student supplies will benefit the public by supporting student learning in Science,

Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM), a discipline where the numbers of people entering the workforce is on the decline; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council Districts 1 and 4 recommend a total allocation of \$7,890 to Elementary Institute of Science for the purposes set forth in this resolution, as follows: Council District 1 – \$2,500 (lab coats/supplies) and Council District 4 - \$5,390 (public safety improvements);
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: “Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2020 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and Elementary Institute of Science for its Program (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$7,890 for the purposes described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-**312954**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$2,500 from Council District 1: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1101110001 GL 512059; and \$5,390 from Council District 4: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost

Center No. 1104110004 GL 512059, for a total of \$7,890, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
