A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN CALTRANS AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE RELINQUISHMENT OF STATE ROUTE 75.

WHEREAS, Caltrans is proposing to relinquish State Route 75 (SR-75) between Interstate 5 (I-5) and Georgia Street to the City of San Diego. SR-75 is a thirteen-mile highway that goes through the City of San Diego, City of Imperial Beach, and City of Coronado and the segment located within the City of San Diego (City) limit is approximately one-mile long between I-5 and Georgia Street; and

WHEREAS, in December 2016, Caltrans prepared the SR-75 Relinquishment

Assessment Report and concluded that SR-75 does not serve regional or statewide transportation needs and can be considered for relinquishment, which will allow local agencies to have more control over traffic operations of the road and to implement improvements that better represent community interests; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, Caltrans completed the relinquishment of SR-75 between Georgia Street to 1.2 miles west of Georgia Street to the City of Imperial Beach and shortly afterwards, Caltrans and the City started negotiating relinquishment of SR-75 within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, as part of the negotiation, Caltrans worked with City staff from the Transportation & Storm Water Department to assess condition of infrastructure within the relinquishment limit that included evaluating the condition of the existing roadway pavement, sidewalks, curb ramps, storm drain systems, signal equipment, and signages. At the end of the

evaluation, Caltrans and City staff agreed that \$5,000,000 is sufficient to bring the roadway and

related infrastructure into compliance with current City standards; and

WHEREAS, after relinquishment, this segment of SR-75 will be owned and maintained

by the City and as part of the relinquishment, the City will receive \$5,000,000 for improvements

within the project limit which include roadway repair and overlay, replacement of sidewalks,

curb ramps, curb and gutter, signal and storm drain upgrades; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to negotiate and execute, for and on 1.

behalf of the City, a Cooperative Agreement with Caltrans, for the relinquishment of

SR-75 between I-5 and Georgia Street, under the terms and conditions set forth in the

Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 312966

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept and deposit up to

\$5,000,000 in Fund 400264, Private and Other Contrib - CIP, for improvements to

SR-75 between I-5 and Georgia Street, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed

relinquishment agreement and receipt of funds.
