A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$5,445 TO TARIQ KHAMISA
FOUNDATION FOR ITS TKF TRAINING INSTITUTE,
PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL
FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND
SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, Tariq Khamisa Foundation has requested funding for its TKF Training Institute Training (Program); and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used for rent and staffing costs to develop training materials for online access for educators; and

WHEREAS, Tariq Khamisa Foundation's request for funding for its Program will benefit the public by supporting the TKF Training Institute Program serves its mission of educating and advocating for today's most at-risk youth; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council Districts 1, 4, and 5 recommend a total allocation of \$5,445 to the Tariq Khamisa Foundation for the purposes set forth in this resolution, as follows: Council

District 1 – \$1,000; Council District 4 –\$2,945; and Council District 5 - \$1,500; NOW,
THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: “An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: “Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2020 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and the Tariq Khamisa Foundation for TKF Training Institute (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$5,445 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 312981.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$1,000 from Council District 1: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1101110001 GL 512059; \$2,945 from Council District 4: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1104110004 GL 512059; and \$1,500 from Council District 5: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1105110005 GL 512059, for

a total of \$5,445, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
