A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE FY20 COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS AND SERVICES FUNDING ALLOCATIONS TO OLD TOWN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, SAN DIEGO CONVENTION AND TOURIST BUREAU, SOUTH PARK BUSINESS GROUP, TRANSFAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES, UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, AND UPTOWN COMMUNITY SERVICE CENTER ARE CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301 AND 15323.

WHEREAS, Old Town Chamber of Commerce is receiving grant funds through the FY20 Community Projects, Programs and Services funding allocation for its Founder's Day Festival (Project); and

WHEREAS, San Diego Convention and Tourist Bureau is receiving grant funds through the FY20 Community Projects, Programs and Services funding allocation for the Balboa Park Local Marketing Initiative (Project); and

WHEREAS, South Park Business Group is receiving grant funds through the FY20 Community Projects, Programs and Services funding allocation for Clean Up South Park (Project); and

WHEREAS, TransFamily Support Services is receiving grant funds through the FY20 Community Projects, Programs and Services funding allocation for Outreach (Project); and

WHEREAS, University Heights Community Development Corporation is receiving grant funds through the FY20 Community Projects, Programs and Services funding allocation for the 23rd Annual Summer in the Park Concert Series (Project); and

WHEREAS, Uptown Community Service Center is receiving grant funds through the FY20 Community Projects, Programs and Services funding allocation for Center Services (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Projects are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and section 15323 (Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings) and that no exception to the exemptions, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, apply to the Projects; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Projects, and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2020, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Projects as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Projects will not have a significant effect on the environment because the Projects involve the normal use of existing facilities and do not involve expansion of the facilities' normal uses; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Projects are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and section 15323 (Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings) and that an exception to the exemptions do not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemptions as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
