A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$29,900 TO WORKSHOPS FOR WARRIORS, INC. FOR EQUIPMENT FOR MACHINING CLASSROOM, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Workshops for Warriors, Inc. has requested funding for the equipment for a machining classroom; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used to purchase a welding booth with lights, a welding curtain, welding stand and jig, argon piping, air pipe, argon flowmeters, and curriculum development materials; and

WHEREAS, the Workshops for Warriors's request for funding for equipment for machining classroom will benefit public by connecting veterans to training opportunities that lead to meaningful careers and help strengthen the San Diego economy; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council Districts 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 recommend a total allocation of \$29,900 to Workshops for Warriors for the purposes set forth in this resolution, attributed as follows: Council District 1 – \$5,000; Council District 2 – \$5,000; Council District 4 – \$2,000; Council District 5 – \$6,700; Council District 6 – \$5,000; Council District 7 – \$1,500; and Council District 8 –\$4,700; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2020 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and Workshops for Warriors (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$29,900 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-313017

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$5,000 from Council District 1: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1101110001 GL512059; \$5,000 from Council District 2: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1102110002 GL512059; \$2,000 from Council District 4: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1104110004 GL512059; \$6,700 from Council District 5: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund

No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1105110005 GL512059; \$5,000 from Council District 6:

Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center

No. 1106110006 GL512059, \$1,500 from Council District 7: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1107110007 GL512059; and \$4,700 from
