A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$31,500 TO YMCA OF SAN DIEGO COUNTY FOR THE LOFT TEEN AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM, YFS BUILDING ENHANCEMENTS AND VIRTUAL WELLNESS & LEARNING SUPPORT, AND YMCA COLLEGE READINESS, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, YMCA of San Diego County has requested funding for programs hosted by 4 satellite YMCA locations: Peninsula Family YMCA (Loft Teen After-School Program), Youth & Family Services (Building Beautification), Rancho Family YMCA (Virtual Wellness & Learning), and Border View Family YMCA (College Readiness) (Programs); and

WHEREAS, YMCA of San Diego County's request for funding for its Programs will benefit the public by providing providing transportation for those with limited driving abilities so that they may access needed services, such as medical appointments and shopping for basic needs; and

WHEREAS, Peninsula Family YMCA's Loft Teen After-School Program was postponed into FY21 due to the COVID-19 emergency and restrictions; and

WHEREAS, YMCA's Agreement has been amended to allow for reimbursement of expenses incurred in FY20, notwithstanding the fact that its Loft Teen After-School Program will take place in FY21; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council Districts 2, 3, 5 and 8 recommend a total allocation of \$31,500 to YMCA of San Diego County for the purposes set forth in this resolution, as follows: Council District 2 – \$4,000; Council District 3 - \$5,000; Council District 5 –\$2,500; and Council District 8 - \$20,000; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2020 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and YMCA of San Diego County for its Service (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$31,500 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-313019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$4,000 from Council District 2: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1102110002 GL 512059; \$5,000 from

Council District 3: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1103110003 GL 512059; \$2,500 from Council District 5: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1105110005 GL 512059; and \$20,000 from Council District 8: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center No. 1108110008 GL 512059, for a total of \$31,500, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
