A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS TO ANY BODY CAN YOUTH FOUNDATION, BAYVIEW COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, FOURTH DISTRICT SENIORS RESOURCE CENTER, GRID ALTERNATIVES SAN DIEGO, AND GROUNDWORK SAN DIEGO – CHOLLAS CREEK, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, TITLED “CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES.”

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled “City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services” on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City received and evaluated five applications for Community Projects, Programs and Services (CPPS) funding for the following purposes:

ORGANIZATION	PROGRAM/ACTIVITY	USE OF FUNDS/PUBLIC BENEFIT
Any Body Can Youth Foundation	Operating Costs	Funds will be used for rent and staff salaries. The public will benefit by supporting an organization that engages at-risk students and giving them information on the skills, tools and opportunities to achieve their goals. ABCYF has increased its online presence further providing direction and connection.

ORGANIZATION	PROGRAM/ACTIVITY	USE OF FUNDS/PUBLIC BENEFIT
Bayview Community Development Corporation	Community Outreach	Funds will be used for graphics, printing, and postage for neighborhood communication. The public will benefit from the expenditure by encouraging community communication regarding neighborhood issues.
Fourth District Seniors Resource Center	Senior Nutrition Program	Funds will be used for food handling and kitchen equipment, supplies, culinary and administrative staff, outreach and utility costs for curbside meal pick-up and home delivery during the COVID-19 pandemic. The public will benefit by providing seniors with a healthy meal option at a time when meal options are limited.
GRID Alternatives San Diego	Energy for All Program	Funds will be used for safety equipment and personal protective equipment for construction staff. The public will benefit by assisting construction staff in installing no-cost solar systems for families and affordable housing owners.
Groundwork San Diego – Chollas Creek	Creek to Bay Bike Ride	Funds will be used for marketing materials, social media outreach, and project management. The public will benefit by supporting the City of San Diego's and SANDAG's Active Transportation goals.

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described programs are consistent with the parameters outlined in Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to Any Body Can Youth Foundation for support as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 further recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to Bayview Community Development Corporation for support as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 further recommends an allocation of \$2,500 to Fourth District Seniors Resource Center for support as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 further recommends an allocation of \$2,000 to GRID Alternatives San Diego for support as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 further recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to Groundwork San Diego – Chollas Creek for support as set forth in this resolution NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: “An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any goods, supplies, or materials which have already been purchased.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: “Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, CPPS FY 2020 City Council Allocation Agreements

between the City of San Diego and (1) Any Body Can Youth Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, (2) Bayview Community Development Corporation in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, (3) Fourth District Seniors Resource Center in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,500, (4) GRID Alternatives San Diego in an amount not to exceed \$2,000, and (5) Groundwork San Diego – Chollas Creek in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-313033.1 for Any Body Can Youth Foundation; Document No. RR-313033.2 for Bayview Community Development Corporation; Document No. RR-313033.3 for Fourth District Seniors Resource Center; Document No. RR-313033.4 for GRID Alternatives San Diego; and Document No. RR-313033.5 for Groundwork San Diego – Chollas Creek.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend a total amount not to exceed \$19,500 from the CPPS budget Fund No. 10000, Cost Center 1104110004 GL512059, to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.


