A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT DECLARING THE CITY-OWNED REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1449 NINTH AVENUE SURPLUS LAND IN ACCORDANCE WITH CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 54221 IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15061 AND 15312.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to declare that certain City-owned real property located at 1449 Ninth Avenue, San Diego CA 92101 as surplus land in accordance with California Government Code section 54221 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15061(b)(2) and (3) and 15312 (Surplus Government Property Sales) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2020, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and

considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project

will not have a significant effect on the environment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent

judgement, determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA

Guidelines sections 15061 and 15312 and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in

CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
