A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS TO ALTERNATIVE HEALING NETWORK, CALIFORNIA STATE GAMES, HILLCRES BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION, MISSION HILLS TOWN COUNCIL, AND NORTH PARK COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, TITLED "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City received and evaluated five applications for Community Projects,
Programs and Services (CPPS) funding for the following purposes:

ORGANIZATION	PROGRAM/ACTIVITY	USE OF FUNDS/PUBLIC BENEFIT
Alternative Healing Network	Art Around Adams	Funds will be used for production items for the Art Around Adams event that has been postponed to next year. The public will benefit by promoting art and culture among San Diego youth.

ORGANIZATION	PROGRAM/ACTIVITY	USE OF FUNDS/PUBLIC BENEFIT
California State Games	2019 Badminton Tournament	Funds will be used for Balboa Park Activity Center fees that holds the Badminton Tournament. The public benefits by supporting Olympic style competition in San Diego, thereby exposing tournament participants, family and friends to the San Diego community.
Hillcrest Business Improvement Association	2019 Pride of Hillcrest Block Party and Stonewall Rally.	Funds will be used for expenses for the event, such as sanitation and fencing, generators, staging, medical services, and security. The public will benefit by expanding events of Pride weekend and enabling access of the public to no-cost events.
Mission Hills Town Council	2019 Summer Concerts in Pioneer Park	Funds will be used for expenses related to producing the 2019 concert series, including the performers, sound and stage equipment, permit fees, trash removal, publicity, insurance, and record keeping. The public will benefit from a community family friendly event that is free of charge that brings people together from local neighborhoods.

ORGANIZATION	PROGRAM/ACTIVITY	USE OF FUNDS/PUBLIC BENEFIT
North Park Community Association	2019 Bird Park Summer Concerts	Funds will be used for purchasing staging equipment for the concert series. The public will benefit by offering a free of charge community event to enjoy with local residents.

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described programs are consistent with the parameters outlined in Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$2,500 to Alternative Healing Network for support as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 further recommends an allocation of \$1,500 to California State Games for support as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 further recommends an allocation of \$20,000 to Hillcrest Business Improvement Association for support as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 further recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to Mission Hills Town Council for support as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 further recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to North Park

Community Association for support as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Alternative Healing Network's Program was postponed into FY21 due to the COVID-19 emergency and restrictions; and

WHEREAS, Alternative Healing Network's Agreement has been amended to allow for reimbursement of expenses incurred in FY20, notwithstanding the fact that the Program will take place in FY21; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any goods, supplies, or materials which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: "Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, CPPS FY 2020 City Council Allocation Agreements between the City of San Diego and (1) Alternative Healing Network in an amount not to exceed \$2,500, (2) California State Games in an amount not to exceed \$1,500, (3) Hillcrest Business Improvement Association in an amount not-to-exceed \$20,000, (4) Mission Hills Town Council in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, and (5) North Park Community Association in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-313057⁻¹ for Alternative Healing Network; Document No. RR-313057⁻² for California State Games; Document No. RR-313057⁻³ for Hillcrest Business Improvement Association; Document No. RR-313057⁻⁴ Mission Hills Town Council; and Document No. RR-313057⁻⁵ for North Park Community Association.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend a total amount not to exceed \$34,000 from the CPPS budget Fund No. 10000, Cost Center 1103110003 GL512059, to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
