A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO REALLOCATE HOMELESS EMERGENCY AID PROGRAM BLOCK GRANT FUNDING AWARDED TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO BY THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, the State of California Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP) is a block grant program designed to provide direct assistance to localities to address the homelessness crisis throughout California; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) was awarded \$14,110,397.95 in HEAP funding which was accepted, appropriated and expended by way of Resolution R-312127 (Dec. 5, 2018); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to HEAP grant requirements, included in the above-referenced resolution is an allocation of the funds amongst specific eligible use categories which were approved by City Council and by the State; and

WHEREAS, consistent with R-312127, Council must approve any reallocation of grant funding from that which was originally approved; and

WHEREAS, the Staff Report, a copy of which is included in the backup materials, illustrates the current distribution of funds and the proposed reallocation of funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee continues to be authorized to negotiate, execute, and comply with the agreement with the State of California's Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency for the HEAP block grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City is authorized to reallocate HEAP grant funding, as follows:

- 1. Increase Capital Improvements by \$42,818.98;
- 2. Increase Services by \$214,693.02; and
- 3. Decrease Rental Assistance by \$257,512.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the allocations by category, subject to State approval, and allowing for adjustment of up to 20% of the estimated amount to reflect actual program or project costs within each category provided the total expenditure does not exceed \$14,110,397.95, are therefore proposed to be:

authorized to take all necessary action to administer, monitor, and manage the HEAP block grant

agreement, and, when required, to develop, advertise, negotiate, and award contracts to third

parties to implement the HEAP block grant agreement.
