A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO GRANTING THE APPEAL OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION FOR WEBSTER GAS – PROJECT NO. 611561.

WHEREAS, an application was submitted to the City of San Diego for a Neighborhood
Use Permit (NUP) for the installation of a gas station (Project) located at 4727 Federal
Boulevard in the CC-5-3 zone and the Mid-City Communities Plan; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2020, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Development Services Department determined the Project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15332, In-Fill Development Projects (Environmental Determination), and a Notice of Right to Appeal the Environmental Determination was posted; and

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2020, Adel H. Somo filed an appeal of the Environmental Determination (Appeal); and

WHEREAS, the Appeal was set for public hearing to be conducted by the City Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) on June 23, 2020, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the Appeal and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered, in light of the whole record, the Environmental Determination, the potential impacts associated with the Project, including the analysis of the Project's transportation impacts, and the issues raised on appeal; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body

and where a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals

affected by the decision and where the City Council was required by law to consider evidence at

the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Appeal is

granted, and the Environmental Determination is set aside and returned to staff to analyze the

Project's impacts based on the Vehicle Miles Traveled metric.
