A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR CALIFORNIA STATEWIDE PARK DEVELOPMENT AND COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS, AND ALL RELATED ACTIONS, FOR THE JOHN F. KENNEDY NEIGHBORHOOD PARK PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the California Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature and Governor of the State of California for the administration of the Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant Program (Grant Program), setting up necessary procedures governing the application; and

WHEREAS, the procedures established by the California Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant's Governing Body to certify by resolution the approval of the grant application before submission of the application to the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) wishes to apply for \$3,000,000 in Grant Program funding for the John F. Kennedy Neighborhood Park Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, successful applicants will enter into a contract with the State of California to complete the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego (Council), that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to make an application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant Program (Grant Program) for an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 for the John F. Kennedy Neighborhood Park Project ("Project").

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council certifies the City has or will have available, prior to commencement of project work utilizing specified grant funds, sufficient funds, including those provided by this grant, to complete the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council certifies that the City has or will provide sufficient funds to operate and maintain the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council certifies that the City has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to conduct all negotiations, sign, and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the grant's scope of work.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, and guidelines.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City will consider promoting inclusion per Public Resource Code section 80001(b)(8 A-G).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure funding from the California Department of Parks and Recreation for the completion of the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 in Grant Program funding for the Project, if the grant funding is secured, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates that funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase

the Capital Improvements Program Budget (CIP) in CIP AGF00007 Park Improvements,

(B18005, John F. Kennedy NP Restroom & Playground Improvement), and to appropriate and

expend an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 from Fund 600001 Grant Fund - State for the

purpose of the Project, contingent upon the receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, if the

grant funding is secured, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more

certificates that funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any grant funding discussed above is secured, the

Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for such

grant, if required.
