A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND \$300,000 IN GRANT FUNDING AND ANY ADDITIONAL FUNDING MADE AVAILABLE FROM THE BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE 2020 DNA CAPACITY ENHANCEMENT FOR BACKLOG REDUCTION PROGRAM FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO FIVE YEARS.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department Crime Laboratory processes and analyzes forensic DNA evidence; and

WHEREAS, since 2008, the San Diego Police Department has received grant funding from the National Institute of Justice, now renamed the Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the DNA Capacity Enhancement for Backlog Reduction Program (Program); and

WHEREAS, the Program works to reduce forensic DNA sample turnaround time, increase the throughput of DNA samples through the Crime Laboratory, and reduce DNA forensic casework backlogs; and

WHEREAS, in 2015, the Council authorized grant funding for five years in San Diego Resolution R-310006 (October 9, 2015); and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department desires to continue the Program and grant funding to further reduce DNA forensic casework backlogs and decrease turnaround time; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department now seeks authority to apply for, accept, appropriate and expend grant funding from the Bureau of Justice Assistance 2020 DNA Capacity Enhancement for Backlog Reduction Program for a period of up to five years; and

WHEREAS, approval by the Council is required by the terms of the grant; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized, on behalf of the City to apply for and accept \$300,000 and any additional

grant funding authorized by the Bureau of Justice Assistance 2020 DNA Capacity Enhancement

for Backlog Reduction Program, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the

grant, for a period of up to five years, from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2025, for the

purpose of implementing the Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase

the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget, and to accept, appropriate and expend \$300,000 and any additional

grant funding authorized by the Bureau of Justice Assistance 2020 DNA Capacity Enhancement

for Backlog Reduction Program, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the

grant, for a period of up to five years, from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2025, for the

purpose of implementing the Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter

into all agreements and certifications necessary for the purpose of implementing the Program.
