AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXTENDING FRANCHISE OF SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY TO CONSTRUCT, USE, AND MAINTAIN POLES, WIRES, AND APPURTENANCES IN THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRICITY TO CUSTOMERS INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE CITY.

WHEREAS, by San Diego Ordinance O-10466 effective on January 17, 1971 (Ordinance O-10466), the City of San Diego (City) granted to San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) a 50-year franchise to construct, use, and maintain poles, wires, and appurtenances in, on, and under the streets of the City for the purpose of transmitting and distributing electric power to customers inside and outside the City (Electric Franchise); and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the expiration of the Electric Franchise, the City in 2019 commenced a process for the advertisement and award of a new electric franchise; and

WHEREAS, the process of letting a new electric franchise cannot be culminated prior to the expiration of the existing Electric Franchise; and

WHEREAS, both the City and SDG&E desire to extend the term of the existing Electric Franchise for a period of 135 days through June 1, 2021, under the same terms and conditions to provide time for the culmination of the process of letting a new electric franchise or further extending and or amending the existing Electric Franchise; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of San Diego that:

Section 1. The term of the Electric Franchise granted to San Diego Gas & Electric Company by Ordinance O-10466 on December 17, 1970, as amended by San Diego Ordinance O-19030 on January 28, 2002 (Ordinance O-19030), to construct, use, and maintain poles, wires,

and appurtenances in, on, and under the streets of the City for the purpose of transmitting and

distributing electric power to customers inside and outside the City, is hereby extended for a

period of 135 calendar days commencing on January 18, 2021 through June 1, 2021, and the

San Diego Gas & Electric Company shall be deemed to have been granted a franchise for said

purposes for that period of time.

Section 2. The terms and conditions of the franchise granted and extended by Section 1 of

this ordinance shall be identical to and the same in every respect as the terms and conditions in

the Electric Franchise granted by Ordinance O-10466 on December 17, 1970, as amended by

Ordinance O-19030 on January 28, 2002.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
