AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH
CENTRALSQUARE TECHNOLOGIES FOR NEXT
GENERATION COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH RESOURCE
MANAGEMENT AND INFORMATION SHARING SOLUTION

WHEREAS, the San Diego Urban Area includes five local government fire communication centers which provide emergency 911 dispatching service for fire and emergency medical services: the City of San Diego (City), City of Escondido, County of San Diego (CALFIRE), North County Dispatch Joint Powers Authority, and Heartland Communications Facility Authority (Member Agencies); and

WHEREAS, these local government emergency, 911 dispatching centers identified a need to update the current Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) to CAD system that supports the dispatching service for fire and emergency medical services and connects the Member Agencies throughout the San Diego Urban Area; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2020, the City issued a Request for Proposal (RFP), RFP No. 10089695-21-K, for a Next Generation CAD to CAD Resource Management and Information Sharing Solution (NGC2C Solution); and

WHEREAS, after a comprehensive review of the proposals submitted in response to the RFP, the City selected CentralSquare Technologies' proposal as the best overall value to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to enter into a contract with CentralSquare Technologies to create, implement, and provide maintenance for a NGC2C Solution; and

WHEREAS, all five Member Agencies will participate in the NGC2C Solution; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego will serve as the NGC2C Solution contractor administrator on behalf of the Member Agencies; and

WHEREAS, this item will approve execution and award of a contract for a NGC2C Solution with CentralSquare Technologies for a five (5) year term with five (5) additional one-year options to renew;

WHEREAS, the total value of the contract for all Member Agencies is \$2,859,784;

WHEREAS, the creation, implementation, and first year maintenance costs of the contract will be funded by the Urban Area Security Initiative Grant in the amount of \$730,325;

WHEREAS, once grant funds are no longer available, the annual maintenance and support costs will be shared amongst the Member Agencies utilizing a cost allocation formula;

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the City's share of annual maintenance and support for the remaining nine years of the contract will be approximately \$716,000 based on the cost allocation formula;

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance approval by a two-thirds majority of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to award and execute an agreement with CentralSquare Technologies for the Next Generation CAD to CAD Resource Management and Information Sharing Solution, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO 21307

Section 2. Upon the expiration of funding through an award of Urban Area Securities Initiative Grant Funding for Fiscal Year 2022, funding in future fiscal years shall be contingent upon adoption of the Appropriation Ordinance for each fiscal year and upon the Chief Financial Officer certifying that funds necessary for the expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


