AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH STREAMLINE AUTOMATION SYSTEMS FOR FIRE INSPECTION SOFTWARE.

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2016, the City of San Diego (City) entered into a five-year agreement with Streamline Automation Systems (Streamline) for the provision of a fire inspection software system (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the fire inspection software system allows the Fire-Rescue Department to efficiently conduct required inspection of educational, residential and commercial occupancies within the jurisdiction of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement with Streamline expires on May 18, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City now seeks approval of an Ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or his designee to execute the First Amendment to the Agreement with Streamline to extend the Effective Date for eighteen (18) months, in an amount not to exceed \$223,349, to provide sufficient time to develop a comprehensive request for proposal for fire inspection software to meet the current needs of the Fire-Rescue Department; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

(O-2021-108)

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of

said City, the First Amendment to Fire Inspection Software Systems between the City of San

Diego and Streamline, extending the Effective Date to November 18, 2022, under the terms and

conditions set forth in the First Amendment to the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City

Clerk as Document No. OO 21308

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to

exceed \$223,349, for the purpose of executing this First Amendment to the Agreement,

contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year

and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first certifying funds are available providing

funds for the above referenced Project.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering

department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a

written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to

the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
