AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO AUTHORIZE THE CONTRACT FOR EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICE, 9-1-1 RESPONSE, ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT TRANSPORT AND STANDBY SERVICE WITH FALCK MOBILE HEALTH CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego began providing professional emergency medical services to the City of San Diego through a contracted paramedic ambulance company in 1979; and

WHEREAS, the current contract for emergency ambulance services expires on June 30, 2022; however, if another service provider is selected as the result of a competitive process, the current contract will terminate six (6) months from the effective date of an Ordinance or Resolution approving a contract to another service provider; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2020, the City issued Request for Proposal No. 10089666-21-K for Emergency Ambulance Service, 9-1-1 Response, Advanced Life Support Transport, and Standby Service (RFP); and

WHEREAS, after a comprehensive review of the proposals, the City selected Falck Mobile Health Corporation's (Falck) proposal as the best overall value to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to enter into a contract with Falck for the City's emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, this item will execute and award a contract for emergency medical services with Falck for an approximate six (6) month transition period, plus a five-year term with five option years, at no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for

a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance approval by a two-thirds

majority of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute, for and on

behalf of the City, the contract for Emergency Ambulance Service, 9-1-1 Response, Advanced

Life Support Transport and Standby Service with Falck. under the terms and conditions set forth

in the contract entitled "Contract Resulting from Request for Proposal Number RFP No.

10089666-21-K" on file with the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21313

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
