DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 1 4 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE PROGRAM MANAGER POSITION AND ONE PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITION IN THE MOBILITY DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2021, the San Diego Civil Service Commission (Civil Service Commission) reviewed a request from the Mobility Department (Department) to exempt one Program Manager position and one Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will be responsible for developing new citywide mobility policies; implementing mobility improvements to address equity in the City and to align with successful attainment of the City Climate Action Plan goals; formulating policies for the new Department regarding long-range mobility planning, curb space, parking management, accessibility, and new mobility technologies; providing policy and program recommendations consistent with Mayoral direction and Council actions; and serving as the primary point of contact for legal issues for the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Program Coordinator position will be responsible for implementing specific programs within the Department, including shared mobility devices, curb space management, and mobility data management; developing policy and regulations for new mobility technologies and their related contracts; and managing the transfer of data related to the analysis and development of policy and regulations for new mobility technologies and systems; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Manager position and Program Coordinator position as described by the Department to the Civil Service Commission, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is presented to the Council as set forth in the memorandum dated February 5, 2021 to the Honorable Council President and members of the Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Mobility Department initiated advisory review and comment from the Civil Service Commission related to the proposed exemption of one Program Manager position and one Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service. On February 4, 2021, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the proposed exemption and commented favorably as meeting Charter section 117 criteria for placement of the positions in the Unclassified Service. Having considered and reviewed the finding of the Civil Service Commission, as set forth in the memorandum dated February 5, 2021, to the Honorable

Council President and members of the Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service

Commission by the Personnel Director, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service the

one Program Manager and one Program Coordinator position identified in the memorandum by

the Department, and declares the positions to be in the Unclassified Service.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
