DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE AUG 13 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO ESTABLISHING PARKING METER ZONES IN  
DOWNTOWN, MID-CITY AND PACIFIC BEACH  
COMMUNITY PARKING DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has conducted a study pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) section 86.0125(c) in the Downtown Community Parking District (CPD), Mid-City CPD, and Pacific Beach CPD to determine locations for new parking meter zones; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to establish parking meter zones at the following locations: Ocean Boulevard to the west, Ingraham Street to the east, Grand Avenue to the south, and Emerald Street to the north in the Pacific Beach CPD; North Harbor Boulevard to the west, Interstate 5 to the east, West Harbor Drive/East Harbor Drive to the south, and West Laurel Street/Interstate 5 to the north in the Downtown CPD; and Park Boulevard to the west, 70th Street to the east, Thorn Street to the south, and Adams Avenue/El Cajon Boulevard to the north in the Mid-City CPD; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to SDMC section 82.04 and California Vehicle Code (CVC) section 22508, two-hour parking meter zones must be established by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, a parking time limit of two hours will be in effect in the above described locations between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the Mid-City CPD and Pacific Beach CPD, and between the hours of 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. in the Downtown CPD, Sundays and certain holidays excepted, pursuant to SDMC section 86.0128; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. Parking meter zones are established in the Downtown CPD, Mid-City CPD, and Pacific Beach CPD.

Section 2. The installation of parking meters and the necessary signs and markings are authorized to be made in the above described locations.

Section 3. A full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
