AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH STEARNS, CONRAD & SCHMIDT, CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC. TO PROVIDE MIRAMAR LANDFILL GAS COLLECTION SYSTEM OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) operates the Miramar Landfill pursuant to a lease with the United States Department of the Navy (Navy Lease), which grants the City rights to operate the landfill and imposes obligations associated with methane gas created by landfilling operations (Landfill Gas); and

WHEREAS, the Landfill Gas must be collected in a Landfill Gas Collection System and conveyed to facilities for destruction in a manner to comply with applicable law and the Navy Lease; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposals (RFP) for services to operate and maintain the Landfill Gas Collection System was advertised pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3207 and Administrative Regulation 25.60; and

WHEREAS, three responsive proposals were received and in compliance with City Council Policy No. 300-7 a selection panel determined the proposal of Stearns, Conrad, and Schmidt Consulting Engineers, LLC (SCS) provides the best qualifications and value; and

WHEREAS, the work to be performed under the Agreement includes compliance with all applicable law and permit requirements; operation and maintenance of gas migration and air emissions controls; the supply of Landfill Gas obligated to adjacent cogeneration facilities and North Compressor Station; performance of required sampling, testing, and reporting;

performance of repairs and corrective actions; operation, maintenance, and modifications to the Landfill Gas Collection System; and collection, transport, and disposal of all condensate generated at the facilities; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is important to the City's operation of Miramar Landfill to provide for proper management of the Landfill Gas Collection System operations and to ensure continuous compliance with federal, state, and local rules and regulatory requirements; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement, or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to approve and execute, for and on behalf of the City, an Agreement with Stearns, Conrad, and Schmidt Consulting Engineers, LLC to provide Landfill Gas Collection System operations, maintenance, and gas supply services for Landfill Gas originating from the Miramar Landfill, in an amount not to exceed \$20,437,107.60 over a period of seven (7) years from Effective Date, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$20,437,107.60 from the Refuse Disposal Enterprise Fund 700039 for Landfill Gas Collection System operations, maintenance, and gas supply services at the Miramar Landfill, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for applicable fiscal years and the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure in any fiscal year are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
