A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE LAW FIRM OF MEYERS NAVE RIBACK SILVER & WILSON TO PROVIDE CONTINUED LEGAL SERVICES AS PANEL OUTSIDE COUNSEL.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) issued Requests for Proposals (RFPs) in November 2017 and February 2018 seeking to retain panel outside counsel in seven areas of law on an as-needed basis in order to streamline the process for engaging outside counsel to avoid causing delays in City projects moving forward or putting the City at a disadvantage in litigation; and

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2018, the City Council approved the retention of 17 different law firms to represent the City in these seven areas of law, including the law firm of Meyers Nave Riback Silver & Wilson (Law Firm) to represent the City in the areas of "Employment Litigation, Internal Investigations, and Litigation, including Clean Water Act and Stormwater Compliance Issues," "Police Excessive Force/Misconduct Litigation," and "Business and Financial Affairs"; and

WHEREAS, the area of "Business and Financial Affairs" relates to municipal issues that include among other things, the Public Records Act and debarment matters; and

WHEREAS, the Legal Services Agreement awarded to the Law Firm was in an amount not to exceed \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the Law Firm will soon exceed the maximum not-to-exceed amount based on the current work that the Law Firm is performing for the City, which includes representing the City on complex and sensitive employment litigation and Public Records Act (PRA) litigation; and

WHEREAS, the City will also require the legal services of the Law Firm to represent the City to pursue debarment actions against two City contractors which require specialized expertise that the Office of the City Attorney does not currently possess; and

WHEREAS, the Law Firm's services are needed because the Office of the City Attorney lacks capacity to handle these matters as there has been an over 37 percent increase in the number of lawsuits filed against the City over the last few years and there has also been a spike in the number of lawsuits filed and motions that need to be filed and responded to as a result of the court closure for several months earlier in the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, an increase of \$250,000 to the Legal Services Agreement, which would raise the total not-to-exceed amount from \$250,000 to \$500,000, is necessary to avoid a disruption in the Law Firm's services that would impede the current work that the Law Firm is performing which all have deadlines that must be met and will also possibly allow the Law Firm to have capacity to take on additional legal work on an as-needed basis during the remainder of the five-year contract; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has prepared a proposed First Amendment to the Legal Services Agreement (First Amendment), which would increase the maximum contract expenditure for the Law Firm by \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney is not seeking funding for this action

because the funding will come from funds already appropriated by the City Council to various

City departments; and

WHEREAS, the Council's approval of the First Amendment is required pursuant to

San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3207(a)(2) because the contract would exceed \$250,000 in

a fiscal year; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the First Amendment to the Legal Services Agreement with Meyers Nave 1.

Riback Silver & Wilson is approved, and the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute this

First Amendment for and on behalf of the City of San Diego in a total amount not to exceed

\$500,000 (reflecting the \$250,000 increase, above the original \$250,000 contract amount).

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed

\$500,000, for the purpose of executing the First Amendment to the Legal Services Agreement,

with Meyers Nave Riback Silver & Wilson, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual

Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable Fiscal Year and the Chief Financial Officer

furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be,

on deposit with the City Treasurer.
