A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS TO CALRECYCLE FOR THE ORGANICS GRANT PROGRAM AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the State; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Public Resources Code section 42999, CalRecycle has established the Organics Grant Program (Grant Program) to make payments available to local jurisdictions to lower overall greenhouse gas emissions by expanding existing capacity or establishing new facilities in California to reduce the amount of California-generated green material, food materials, or alternative daily cover disposed to landfills; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle has established procedures governing the administration of the Organics Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering the Organics Grant Program require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the Grant Program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to submit applications for the Organics Grant Program to CalRecycle on behalf of the City of San Diego for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 through and including Fiscal Year 2024/2025.

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2. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized and empowered to negotiate and

execute, for and on behalf of the City, all Grant Program-related documents, including

applications, agreements, payment requests, and amendments necessary to secure Grant Program

payments, implement and close out the Grant Program, and administer the City's obligations,

responsibilities, and duties under the terms and conditions of the Grant Program for awards

received for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 through and including Fiscal Year 2024/2025.

3. That, for the purposes of this Grant Program, the Mayor's designee includes the

Environmental Services Department Director and Deputy Director.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend

funds from the Grant Program for the purposes of the Grant Program, contingent upon securing

funding and execution of Grant Program agreements.
