A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
(CALTRANS) FOR FEDERAL GRANT FUNDING FOR THE
EL CAMINO REAL TO VIA DE LA VALLE (1/2 MILE)
PROJECT – HIGHWAY BRIDGE PROGRAM (HBP) GRANT.

WHEREAS, the El Camino Real to Via De La Valle (1/2 Mile) project modifies the segment of El Camino Real between Via De La Valle and San Dieguito Road in order to improve the structural integrity of the bridge over the San Dieguito River, alleviate problems associated with high flood events, improve pedestrian and vehicular access to nearby coastal and recreational resources, relieve traffic congestion, and improve consistency with the adopted land use plan for the project area (Project); and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements include raising and widening the roadway and replacing the bridge with a structure that is also raised and wider with approximately 1,000 feet of Via De La Valle widened to accommodate new turn lanes from El Camino Real, and drainage improvements will be constructed along the southern edge of Via De La Valle, from existing El Camino Real to El Camino Real North; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, City staff applied for and received approval for a \$1,700,000 million federal grant under the HBRR Program for preliminary engineering (R-299773); and

WHEREAS, in 2011, City staff applied for and received approval to accept Program Supplement Agreement No. 137 Rev. 1 for a \$1,428,000 million federal grant under the HBRR Program for preliminary engineering (O-20015); and

WHEREAS, in 2011, City staff applied for and received approval to accept Program Supplement Agreement No. 137 Rev. 2 for a \$2,560,000 million federal grant under the Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) for preliminary engineering (R-306817); and

WHEREAS, this action will authorize all necessary actions to secure, accept, appropriate and expend federal grant funds for the right-of-way phase of the Project, not to exceed \$2,000,000 under the Highway Bridge Program (HBP); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to take all necessary actions to make application to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and to secure Highway Bridge Program (HBP) grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 CIP S-0856, El Camino Real to Via De LaValle (1/2 Mile), to support right-of-way engineering, administration, and acquisition for the El Camino Real to Via De LaValle (1/2 Mile) (Project).

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend Highway Bridge Program grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvement Program Budget in CIP S-00856, El Camino Real to Via De LaValle (1/2 Mile), and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 within Fund 600000, Grant Fund – Federal.
