# A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ESTABLISHING THE TIERRASANTA BANNER DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION AND DISPLAY OF BANNERS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY. 

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section $142.1210(\mathrm{~b})(5)(\mathrm{C})$ allows the placement of banners in public right of ways that are used for promoting cultural or civic events or activities of general public interest on streets and public rights-of-way designated by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tierrasanta Community Council and Planning Group is a non-profit civic organization founded to promote the enhancement of quality of life for residents of the Tierrasanta community; and

WHEREAS, the Tierrasanta Community Council and Planning Group wishes to install street banners in the public right-of-way promoting cultural and civic events, community activities of general public interest, and to celebrate the community; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego wishes to aid this civic endeavor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. In accordance with San Diego Municipal Code section 142.1210 (b)(5)(C), the Tierrasanta Community Council and Planning Group may install banners along the following streets:
a. Tierrasanta Boulevard from . 2 miles east of the I-15 North On/Off Ramps to Copperleaf Lane;
b. Clairemont Mesa Boulevard from Repecho Road to Rueda Drive;
c. Aero Drive from . 2 miles east of the I-15 North On/Off Ramps to Santo Road;
d. Santo Road from Corporal Drive to Portobelo Drive;
e. Antigua Boulevard from Santo Road to Via Vallarta; and
f. Via Vallarta from Antigua Boulevard to Clairemont Mesa Boulevard.
2. The banners shall be installed in accordance with the following:
a. The banners shall not be used for commercial or political advertising, except that logos and trademarks of sponsoring organizations shall be permitted.
b. The total area of logos and trademarks shall be limited to five percent of the banner area.
c. The banners shall be displayed for no more than thirty calendar days, with one thirty-calendar day extension.
d. The banners shall be installed only on light standards that have been equipped by the City with approved mounting hardware.
e. The banners have received all necessary permits to locate in the public right-of-way.
