

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 313700DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE SEP 27 2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE
TO APPLY FOR AND TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS TO
SECURE GRANT FUNDING FROM THE UNITED STATES
DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION AND TO ADMINISTER
THE GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL
OFFICER TO ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND
GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING; AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2017, the President of the United States declared a major
disaster for the State of California as a result of severe winter storms, flooding, and mudslides
that occurred in January 2017 (2017 Incident) under FEMA-4305-DR-CA (Major Disaster
Declaration); and

WHEREAS, San Diego was included among the counties authorized for assistance under
the Major Disaster Declaration; and

WHEREAS, Congress provided the United States Department of Commerce, Economic
Development Administration (EDA) with supplemental funding for disaster relief and recovery
grants to assist communities that received a Major Disaster Declaration in calendar year 2017
(2018 EDA Disaster Supplemental Grant Program); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) is seeking public works construction assistance
for implementation of an infrastructure project to directly alleviate impacts of the 2017 Incident
(Maple Canyon Restoration Project); and

WHEREAS, the EDA approved the City's application for funding in the amount of \$5,975,582 for the Maple Canyon Restoration Project under the 2018 EDA Disaster Supplemental Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of \$5,975,583 are a requirement for receiving funds under the 2018 EDA Disaster Supplemental Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, matching funds will be provided from the Green Infrastructure Annual Allocation ACC00001; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or designee is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to take all necessary actions to apply to the United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration and secure 2018 EDA Disaster Supplemental Grant Program funding in an amount not to exceed \$5,975,582.00 for CIP ACC00001, Stormwater Green Infrastructure CIP (B-12040, Maple Canyon Restoration - Phases 1 & 2) to support administration, project management, design and construction of the Maple Canyon Restoration Project.

2. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized for and on behalf of the City to take all actions required to administer the 2018 EDA Disaster Supplemental Grant and the City's obligations, responsibilities, and duties under the 2018 EDA Disaster Supplemental Grant Program.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend 2018 EDA Disaster Supplemental Grant Program funding in an amount not to exceed \$5,975,582.00, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required.

5. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvement Program Budget in CIP ACC00001, Stormwater Green Infrastructure CIP (B-12040, Maple Canyon Restoration – Phases 1 & 2) and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$5,975,582.00 within Fund 600000, GRANT FUND-FEDERAL, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
