A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA'S RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ROUND 2 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT, RELATED FEDERAL GUIDANCE, AND ASSEMBLY BILL 832.

WHEREAS, on December 27, 2020, in response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the federal Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (Public Law 116-260) was passed, establishing the federal emergency rental assistance program and providing \$25 billion in coronavirus relief funds for emergency rental assistance for state, local and tribal governments, including \$2.6 billion for the State of California (State), and \$42,333,563 allocated directly to the City of San Diego (City) from the United States Department of the Treasury (Treasury); and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2021, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) pursuant to City Council Resolution R-313439, and the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Housing Authority) pursuant to Housing Authority Resolution HA-1900, authorized the City's COVID-19 Housing Stability Assistance Program (HSAP), which provides rental assistance or utility assistance, or both, to low income households experiencing financial hardship due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City received an additional \$44,877,753.57 in coronavirus relief funds for HSAP from the State as block grant funds, in accordance with Senate Bill (SB) 91; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was enacted, providing a second round of funding for emergency rental assistance, including \$54,539,063.20 in federal funds directly to the City; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2021, California Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill (AB) 832 into law, providing for the "State Rental Assistance Program – Round 2" with ARPA funds, and changes to the rental assistance program guidelines, including allowing HSAP to pay one hundred percent (100%) of past due and prospective rent for qualifying households affected by the Covid-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City was allocated \$39,712,779.17 in State Rental Assistance Program – Round 2 funds, and on October 5, 2021, the City Council adopted Resolution R-313732, approving the acceptance, allocation and transfer of these funds for HSAP; and

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2021, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) requested that the City submit a resolution to clarify that the City has authority to enter into the standard agreement with the State (Standard Agreement) to participate in the State Rental Assistance Program – Round 2, in accordance with the ARPA, related federal guidance, and AB 832; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

The Mayor, or designee, is authorized and directed to sign the Standard
 Agreement and any other required documents to participate in the State Rental Assistance
 Program – Round 2 in accordance with the ARPA, related federal guidance, and AB 832, and to

take any other actions necessary or appropriate to participate in the State Rental

Assistance Program – Round 2 and secure funds from HCD.
