A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE CITY'S GRANT TO SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY OF A GAS PIPELINE EASEMENT ON A PORTION OF CITY-OWNED PROPERTY ALONG McCAIN ROAD, DESIGNATED AS ASSESSOR'S PARCEL NUMBER 450-790-29, IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT UNDER CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15061(b)(3), 15301, AND 15305.

WHEREAS, in accordance with a Gas Pipeline Easement Agreement, the City of San Diego (City) proposes to grant to San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) a 10-footwide easement for a lineal length of 586 feet on the easterly portion of City-owned property along McCain Road, designated as Assessor's Parcel Number 450-790-29, to enable SDG&E to construct and maintain a natural gas pipeline (Project); and

WHEREAS, within the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000, et seq.), Public Resources Code section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000, et seq.) adopted by the California Office of Planning and Research under Public Resources Code section 21083 shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, CEQA Guidelines section 15301 provides a categorical exemption from CEQA for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and

WHEREAS, CEQA Guidelines section 15305 provides a categorical exemption from CEQA for minor alterations in land use limitations in areas with an average slope of less than 20 percent, which do not result in any changes in land use or density; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Department determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15305; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Department further determined that the Project is exempt from CEQA under the common sense exemption in CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3), which provides that CEQA only applies to actions having the potential to cause a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record and related public comment with respect to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council, exercising its independent judgment, determined that the Project will not result in a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15305 and is also exempt from CEQA under the common sense exemption in CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3); and

WHEREAS, the Council, exercising its independent judgment, determined that no exception set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 applies to the Project because no

cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified;

none of the land is adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources will be affected by the

action; and none of the land is identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to California

Government Code section 65962.5; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

The Project will not result in a significant effect on the environment and is 1.

categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15305 and is also

exempt from CEQA under the common sense exemption in CEQA Guidelines section

15061(b)(3).

No exception to the categorical exemptions, set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 2.

15300.2, applies to the Project.
