AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITION IN THE SAN DIEGO CITY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2021, the San Diego Civil Service Commission (Civil Service Commission) reviewed a request from the San Diego City Employees' Retirement System (Department or SDCERS) to exempt one Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Coordinator position will be responsible for managing various Member Services programs. This position will develop policies related to the call center, retirement applications, customer service, and quality assurance; ensure retirement application information complies with the San Diego Municipal Code and SDCERS Board rules; formulate updates to the Confidentiality of Member Information Policy to ensure member identity is protected; develop, implement, and monitor training; analyze service trends and recommend changes to procedures and/or communications; and manage the SDCERS records retention policy and the quality assurance of records; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Coordinator position, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated November 5, 2021 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Department initiated advisory review and comment from the Civil Service Commission related to the proposed exemption of one Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service. On November 4, 2021, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the proposed exemption and commented favorably upon it as meeting Charter section 117 criteria for placement of the Program Coordinator position in the Unclassified Service. Having considered and reviewed the finding of the Civil Service Commission, as set forth in the memorandum dated November 5, 2021 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service the Program Coordinator position in the Department, performing the duties described in the memorandum, and declares the position to be in the Unclassified Service.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage. APPROVED: MARA W.
