ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21471 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 11 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE SECOND
AMENDMENT TO SOFTWARE SUPPORT AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2017, the City of San Diego (City) entered into a five-year agreement with TriTech Software Systems for the annual maintenance and support of its Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) System (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, on August 31, 2020, the Agreement was amended to reflect TriTech Software's merger with Aptean, Superior and Zuercher to form CentralSquare Technologies (CentralSquare); and

WHEREAS, the Fire-Rescue CAD system is a mission critical system for 9-1-1 fire and EMS call triage, resource assignment, event tracking, and event disposition for the City, the City's ambulance provider, and the five partner Fire departments for which the City provides dispatching services (Chula Vista, Coronado, Imperial Beach, National City and Poway); and

WHEREAS, the Fire-Rescue CAD system also provides a mobile client which is used by first responders to track the status of 9-1-1 calls, relay dispatch notes, route units, and place units at scene; and

WHEREAS, the Police and Fire-Rescue Departments are working together to complete a Request for Proposal competitive process which will obtain the best value to the City for its CAD systems; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement with CentralSquare is set to expire on September 30, 2022;
and

WHEREAS, the City now seeks approval of an Ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to execute the Second Amendment to the Agreement with CentralSquare Technologies to extend the term of the agreement by one year through September 30, 2023, with four (4) additional one-year options through September 30, 2027, in an additional amount not to exceed \$5,000,000, to provide sufficient time to complete the competitive process and implement a new CAD system; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of said City, the Second Amendment to the Software Support Agreement between the City of San Diego and CentralSquare Technologies under the terms and conditions set forth in the Second Amendment to the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO - 21471.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 for the purpose of executing this Second Amendment to the Agreement, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first certifying funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 3. That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
