DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 21 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING TWO PROGRAM COORDINATOR  
POSITIONS IN THE SUSTAINABILITY AND MOBILITY  
DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2022, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Sustainability and Mobility Department (Department) to exempt two Program Coordinator positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Energy Program Coordinator position will be responsible for developing policies, plans, and programs to ensure the City achieves its 2035 zero emissions municipal goal. This position will pursue new pathways for building energy retrofits across a large existing building portfolio; coordinate project phases; formulate and administer policies and programs to support the execution of complex building energy projects; and serve in a project management oversight role as retrofits are completed; and

WHEREAS, the Public Power and Franchise Program Coordinator position will be responsible for the administrative oversight of the gas and electric franchises awarded to San Diego Gas and Electric (SDG&E). This position will assist with contract management, consultant oversight, data gathering, and interdepartmental coordination for the study on public power; identify needs and priorities regarding deliverables and phases of the Public Power Feasibility Study; determine the processes, costs, risks, and opportunities in shifting electricity and gas infrastructure in the City to a form of public department agency; and develop policies to advance or significantly change the City's relationship with SDG&E; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or

administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the positions, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated June 3, 2022 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-21501; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the two Program Coordinator positions described by the Department.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


