

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21539 (NEW SERIES)DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE OCT 06 2022AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE PROGRAM MANAGER
POSITION IN THE GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT
FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2022, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the General Services Department (Department) to exempt one Program Manager position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will oversee the implementation of the new Zero Emission Vehicles (ZEV) and Electric Charging infrastructure programs. This position will develop policies related to implementing the City's fleet infrastructure for ZEV and Electric Charging; serve as representative to outside agencies, the Mayoral policy team for ZEV legislation, and federal and state governments for grant opportunities; review, evaluate, and make recommendations for planning and ordering ZEV and Electric Charging infrastructure; create and maintain administrative regulations for the ZEV program; lead efforts for the procurement of ZEV energy monitoring and tracking software systems; advise on ZEV planning, ordering, coordination, oversight, and ZEV replacement and charging infrastructure placement; and attend and present at City Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Manager position, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated March 8, 2022 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-21539; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the one Program Manager position described by the Department.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
