AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE ASNEEDED CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH PSOMAS (H176830) TO EXTEND TIME.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) entered into an as-needed professional services agreement with Psomas on October 9, 2017 for civil engineering design services to support the City's Capital Improvement Projects. These services include, but are not limited to, preparation of construction drawings, contract documents, construction period services, and preparation of various reports; and

WHEREAS, Psomas has received fifteen (15) tasks under the current agreement, of which the following two (2) tasks are still in design and in construction: College Area Sewer and Water and Water Group Job 952. These two tasks are still under design and construction and need additional time to complete resulting in a request for an extension from 60 months to 96 months; and

WHEREAS, to complete this remaining task in the agreement with Psomas, the agreement will need to be amended to add time, which will take their agreement beyond five years; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of

the City, the First Amendment to the Agreement with Psomas to extend the contract duration

from 60 months to 96 months, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or

more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with

the City Treasury, under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment to the

Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21553

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
