DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE OCT 26 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN  
AGREEMENT WITH ROTORCRAFT SUPPORT, INC FOR  
HELICOPTER ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER  
PARTS AND AS-NEEDED HELICOPTER MAINTENANCE  
SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department currently owns and operates one Bell 212 HP helicopter, one Bell 412 EP twin-engine gas turbine medium-lift helicopter and one Sikorsky S70i twin-engine heavy-lift helicopter; and

WHEREAS, the helicopters are outfitted for multi-mission emergency response to provide primary fire, rescue, and emergency medical services to citizens throughout San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, routine repairs, inspections, component overhaul, original equipment manufacturer (OEM) parts and maintenance are required to operate and maintain the helicopters in accordance with the manufacturer mandatory time/life schedules and Federal Aviation Administration regulations; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2022, the City issued Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 10089888-22-W for a five-year Agreement with five additional one-year options to renew for Helicopter Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) Parts and As-Needed Helicopter Maintenance Services for the Fire-Rescue Department; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2022, as a result of the RFP process, the City issued a Notice of Intent to Award to Rotorcraft Support, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to enter into a five-year Agreement with five additional one-year options to renew with Rotorcraft Support, Inc. for Helicopter OEM Parts and As-Needed Helicopter Maintenance Services in an amount not to exceed \$10,400,000 over the ten-year term of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance approval by a two-thirds majority of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a five-year Agreement with five additional one-year options to renew, with Rotorcraft Support, Inc. for original equipment manufacturer parts and as-needed helicopter maintenance services for an amount not to exceed \$10,400,000, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21555.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$10,400,000 from the General Fund, Fund 100000, Fire-Rescue Business Area 1912, over the ten-year term of the Agreement for original equipment manufacturer parts and as-needed helicopter maintenance services, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriations Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
